Winners will receive a certificate, an invitation to deliver a presentation and a contribution towards travel and accommodation to attend the 17th BMOS.

Prepare your documents needed for submission:

- a supporting statement to include a paragraph outlining why attendance at this conference would be beneficial (including future engagements Brazil/UK)
- an abstract of your proposed presentation (ca. 1 page)
- a brief biological sketch [curriculum vitae; ca. 1 page] which should include date of birth, summary of education and career, a list of no more than 5 relevant publications. The biographical sketch [curriculum vitae] should also include evidence of independence and research originality/impact.
